The Fabled Adriatic

Aboard *Island Sky* | April 9 – 20, 2009

Sail the indigo waters of the Adriatic and explore nine World Heritage Sites and legendary medieval cities. We begin with the Mediterranean crossroads island of Malta; discover Sicily's archaeological treasure-trove at Syracuse; follow Croatia's legendary Dalmatian Coast to the splendors of Dubrovnik, Korcula Island, the harbor city of Split, and Sibenik, surrounded by parklands and waterfalls. Timeless Venice, once hailed as "Queen of the Adriatic" makes a fitting final port of call.

Northern Ring Of Fire – Voyage I: Kuril Islands & Kamchatka

Aboard *Clipper Odyssey* | June 10 – 23, 2009

Cruise northward from Hokkaido, Japan, through the stunning wildlife-rich Kuril Islands to Russia's Kamchatka Peninsula, a volcanic wonderland. The rich history of Arctic exploration comes to life as we trace the Ring of Fire. Spectacular scenery and an incredible array of wildlife—whales, seals, otters, and thousands of seabirds—are highlights as we cruise by Zodiac along the pristine shores of this seldom-visited region. *Can be combined with Voyage II below—attractive single rates and combo savings.*



Northern Ring Of Fire – Voyage II: Aleutians & the Bering Sea

Aboard *Clipper Odyssey* | June 21 – July 7, 2009

Our adventure takes us to some of the most remote places on Earth, from the Kamchatka Peninsula to the Commander, Pribilof, and Aleutian Islands, and showcases a wild Pacific realm few travelers witness. Follow in the wake of explorer Vitus Bering, hike in fields of wildflowers, witness huge colonies of seabirds, meet the residents of isolated villages, and view the relics of WWII outposts. Aboard Zodiacs, investigate picturesque bays and uninhabited islets in search of auklets, brown bears, and Arctic foxes. *Can be combined with Voyage I above—attractive single rates and combo savings.*

Beyond Rapa Nui: Easter Island to Tahiti

Aboard *Clipper Odyssey* | October 1 – 20, 2009

Sail the sapphire waters of Oceania to the tropical paradises of the South Pacific. From Easter Island cruise westward to fabled Pitcairn; the gentle, low-lying Tuamotus and their turquoise lagoons; and the exotic lush Marquesas, before concluding in Tahiti. Along the way view the enigmatic *moai*, stone heads of Easter Island, meet the descendants of the HMS *Bounty* mutineers, and enjoy diverse snorkeling and diving experiences.

Aboard *Clipper Odyssey* | October 18 – November 1, 2009

Explore idyllic Polynesia, from Tahiti's soaring peaks to the tiny atolls of the Tuamotus. Our exploration of the Marquesas reveals a natural wonderland of botanical diversity and a conch-shell trumpet welcome ashore is, simply, unforgettable. Dazzling lagoons and the warm translucent waters of the South Pacific offer sublime snorkeling and diving; ashore, walk among the lush verdant landscapes and search sandy shores for the elusive Tuamotu sandpiper. The hospitality of the islanders here is legendary and part of the charming allure of this idyllic island realm.

West Coast of South America


Aboard *Clipper Adventurer* | October 14 – November 2, 2009

As we cruise southward from Ecuador to Peru and Chile witness a huge variety of wildlife, from dolphins and whales to Andean pink flamingoes, from Humboldt penguins to vicuñas and viscachas. Photographers thrill to soaring snow-capped vistas and bustling colorful markets, and cultural explorations highlight four World Heritage Sites, including Chan Chan, once the largest adobe settlement in the world. Optional excursions offer a birds-eye view of the ever-mysterious Nazca Lines, and the famed Atacama Desert.

South Sea Odyssey: Tahiti to Fiji

Aboard *Clipper Odyssey* | November 13 – 29, 2009

Book-ended by the iconic islands of Tahiti and Fiji, our South Pacific journey highlights kaleidoscopic underwater worlds, fascinating cultures, and landscapes that define the essence of paradise. From volcanic mountains to tiny atolls, from black sand beaches to lagoons of impossible clarity, discover a world of supreme beauty and people proud of their ancient heritage. Join us as we snorkel, dive, walk, and photograph the Society and Cook Islands, the Kingdom of Tonga, seldom-visited Wallis and Futuna, and Fiji.



Antarctica, South Georgia & The Falkland Islands

Aboard *Le Diamant* | November 20 – December 11, 2009

Antarctica is a dazzling land of icebergs and pristine snowy landscapes. In the early austral summer we experience the continent's wildlife in transition: huge numbers of raucous penguins are building nests or incubating eggs; "goonies," or young albatross, prepare their giant wings for inaugural flights; and numerous fur seal pups are present on the beaches. On magical South Georgia walk in the footsteps of Sir Ernest Shackleton; in the scenic Falklands witness colonies of gentoo and western rockhopper penguins; and spend five exhilarating days exploring the Antarctic Peninsula.
